English

- Research who lived in a castle
- Draw and label a castle
- Write a story that includes a castle.
- Write a diary entry as if you were a soldier from the Battle of Hastings.
- Visit the library and find books on castles/medieval Britain.
- Make a list of different materials around your home.

Maths



- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Practice writing, reading and counting with numbers to 100.
- Learn number bonds to 20.
- Play board games that include dice.
- Draw, design and measure your castle.

Homework

Creative

- Build a model of a castle.
- Design your own shield
- Design and create a sword using a variety of materials.
- Recreate a Paul Klee piece of art.
- Create an outfit for a princess or a knight.
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Other
