Please find below some suggestions as to learning activities your child could be doing at home during this period of Government enforced school closure. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities each day / week. We would love to hear / see what you have been doing when school re-opens.

English



- Learn to hold a pencil correctly and make marks / colour
- Make models, do lots of cutting & sticking
- Draw on large pieces of paper or cardboard (anything will do).
- Sing nursery rhymes and songs together.
- Help to cook / prepare food to strengthen finger muscles.
- Prepare a show, get dressed up, make tickets, number the seats.

Maths



- Do some jigsaws
- Play shops using real money. Use 1p coins.
- Get your child to tidy and organize things ie knives, forks, socks and spoons into pairs / groups / sets.
- Play games with a dice. Can they recognize the number of dots from the pattern?
- Count your fingers from 1 – 5
- Count objects
- Empty and fill containers with water/soil

- Bake with a family member.
- Learn a new game
- Dance to your favourite songs.
- Make a junk model
- Read stories with your family, tell stories and make up new ones.
