Please find below some suggestions as to learning activities your child could be doing at home during this period of Government enforced school closure. This menu of activities is additional to the theme menus sent home at the beginning of term, which pupils can continue working on as well. Pupils are expected to read for 15 minutes every day and practice their phonics / spellings and times tables every day as well as choosing activities from the selection below. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities each day / week. Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc.) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book to share when school re-opens.

English

 Research Greek mythology. Choose a story and rewrite it – maybe change the main character or rewrite the ending.

Year group: 3

- Make a leaflet about an ancient Greek city.
- Read a book, design a new front cover/draw the setting and write a book review.
- Write a poem about the Greek world.
 Learn it and recite it.
- Write an affirmation a list of qualities that you love – about someone in your family.
- Keep a diary of your time at home and what you have been doing

Mathematics

- Learn 3x, 4x and 8x times tables facts.
- Make the tallest tower you can. You could use spaghetti and marshmallows, straws and blu tac, cardboard and sellotape or just plastic/paper cups.
 Measure how tall you make it.
- Measure amounts for baking using a recipe.
- Learn to tell the time to nearest 5 minutes.
- Create a sundial.
- Have a sports competition/play a game with a family member. Make a tally chart to track points.
- Create a maze. Write a list of instructions for how to get the treasure inside and then escape.
- Teach a family member the different methods you know for calculating numbers.

Creative / Practical

- Make a Greek salad.
- Learn a new skill: sewing, knitting, being a mechanic, decorating etc.
- Create your own mythical creature, drawing a picture and labelling it. Write a story about it.
- Watch Newsround and summarise main stories including the headlines.
- Make a poster including all of your favourite things to do.
- Prepare a 'Show and Tell' about something you are interested in.

Keep a record of the nature which you see/hear near your home.
