### Easy Play dough Recipe

1 Cup of flour  
 ¼ cup of salt  
 ¾ cup of water  
 1 tablespoon of vegetable oil  
 3 table spoons of lemon juice

1. Heat up the water, oil and lemon juice in a pan (not to boiling)
2. Add food colouring
3. Mix the flour and salt in a mixing bowl
4. Add the mixed flour and salt to the pan
5. Stir continuously until the ingredients form a ball – knead the ball of dough.
