### **TEXT MESSAGE SERVICE**

Remember to check School Ping **every day** for messages! This is our main way of communicating with everyone so it is important to check it to avoid missing important information.

#### UNIFORM

It has been lovely seeing all our pupils return to school looking so smart. We hope that this continues throughout the year. May we remind you of the following uniform needs:

**Ties** are **compulsory** for all pupils in years 5&6 — please ensure your child is wearing one when they leave the house each day along with a **stiff collar shirt** (not a polo shirt).

ALL PUPILS NEED A BOOK BAG to take books, letters and learning at home work to and from school. They also will bring their **READING** RECORDS home every day to record their reading at home. Please note that these are expensive documents and, if lost, must be paid for at a cost of £2.

All pupils need a water bottle for use during the day.

Shoes must be plain black and suitable for school.

Hair cuts must not include lines or patterns, die or large accessories.

PE kits must be PLAIN black or navy and PE shirts white and plain. Please note that pupils should come to school on their PE days wearing their full PE kit. Pupils will be told and reminded when PE day is and this will also be on your year group newsletters which will be sent home soon.

## **READING BOOKS**

We are passionate about reading at Eastwood. Reading is an important life skill and a great source of pleasure too. We spend lots of money on lovely books for our pupils to read; we ask for your support with looking after these and returning them to school. Sadly, over 100 books were lost last year from our school stock. To replace these will cost us over £500 which is money we could spend on other things for the pupils. Please look around at home and return any books you find. Thank you.
