Please find below lots of useful information to help you and your children be organised and make the most of their time in our year group. What will my child be learning this term? Our theme for this term is Marvellous Me and Fantastic Families.

The children will be encouraged to talk about themselves, their homes and their families. We will be learning the initial sound of their name and recognise those of their peers. Talk about numbers important to them, their age, their house number and how many people live in their house. Making connections between them and the numerals themselves is crucial. We will be looking at the stories Elmer's Friends, Elmer's Weather and Elmer's Colours and the large family.





How can I help my child at home?

- Ask them what they are learning about in school.
- Make sure they have equipment to do their learning at home.
- Check your child is doing their reading and handing it in on Tuesday or Thursday
- •Listen to your child read every night and talk to them about the book (this can be done in English or the home language).
- Register your child for free books every month from birth to 5 years of age on Keighley's Imagination Library.
