What will my child be learning this term? Our theme for this term is Food Glorious Food

English –To learn to write their 1st initial of their names.

Maths – Recite number to 5 and say one number for each item in order 1, 2,3,4,5.

ICT— To make a picture on interactive whiteboard PHSCE— Me and my Friends.

PE- Match their developing physical skills to tasks and activities in the setting.

DT – Match their developing physical skills to tasks and activities in the setting.

Music – To sing and remember entire song. Pat a Cake baker's man.

How can I help my child at home?

- Ask them what they are learning about in school.
- Make sure they have equipment to do their learning at home.
- Check your child is doing their reading and handing it in on Wednesday.
- •Listen to your child read every night and talk to them about the book (this can be done in English or the home language).
- Register your child for free books every month from birth to 5 years of age on Keighley's Imagination Library.
