We will be learning all about food and taking advantages of our local supermarket and green grocer's. We would like the children to experience a range of taste and of variety different foods in season.

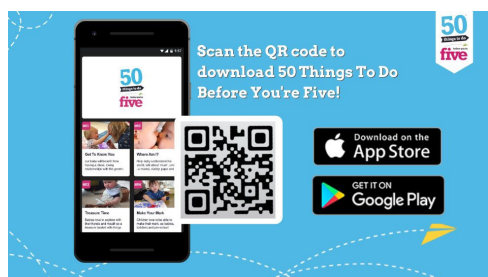
Toilet Training
