

Our library sessions will include a time for the children to read their books and also, we will provide them with an opportunity to listen to a range of texts. Please ensure library books are returned to school each Thursday.Homework Menu: Children will be given a homework menu. They must choose an activity from either English, Maths, Creative or Other.
