<u>What will my child be learning this term?</u> Our theme for this term is <u>Its cold outside!</u>

We split into groups each day to welcome our pupils into class. We also use group time to focus on Maths, Phonics and story activities. In story time we recap stories each week so that pupils become familiar with them. The children will be encouraged to fasten their coats themselves and make sure to put on gloves, hat and scarf.

For outdoor Learning we will going to Bolton Abbey woods where we will be exploring the environment and looking for "Gruffalo. We will going to Prince of Wales Park to look at the water cascade.



How can I help my child at home?

- •Ask them what they are learning about in school.
- Make sure they have equipment to do their learning at home.
- Check your child is doing their reading and handing it in on Tuesday or Thursday
- Listen to your child read every night and talk to them about the book (this can be done in English or the home language).
- Register your child for **free books every month** from birth to 5 years of age on **Keighley's Imagination** Library.
