How can I help my child at home?

- **Singing, action rhymes and sharing books** give children rich opportunities to understand new words.
- Ask them what they are **learning about** in pre-school.
- **Share a story** every night and talk to them about the story (this can be done in English or the home language).
- Register your child for **free books every month** from birth to 5 years of age on **Keighley's Imagination Library**.
