### London's Calling

All of the homework options below are linked to either this theme or other learning from this term such as English / Maths / Science etc.... Pupils are expected to **read for 15 minutes every day** and practice their **phonics / spellings and times tables** every day as well in addition to choosing 1 or 2 things from the options below each week. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example Maths one week, creative the next etc... Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc..) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book (unless it is a model).



#### English/Reading

Look at your library book. Write a short review and say if you enjoyed the book.

- Choose a London landmark and create a fact file.
- Write a poem about London.
- Send or design a postcard.
- Think of 10 nouns and adjectives to describe what you might see in London.
- Write a description of a setting.
- Write a list of questions, what would you like to find out about the Great Fire of London
- Write a diary entry
- Describe a setting thinking about the Great Fire of London.
- Practice reading and writing the common exception words for Y1/2.

#### Maths

- Write your 2x, 5 and 10 x table.
- Create a rap or a chant to learn your 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Practice writing your numbers to 100 in numerals and words.
- Play the number bond catching game (10,20,100)
- Practice reading the time o'clock and half past.
- Roll a dice and practice adding two 2 digit numbers. **123** 3 + 14 = )
- Play Topmarks or BBC Bitesize maths games – ordering numbers, number bonds, counting in 2,5,10's



#### Creative



- Practice mixing primary and secondary colours.
- Imagine that you saw the Great Fire of London - paint a picture of what you saw / make a model of a London Landmark.
- Make a bird feeder using recycled materials.
- Visit Cliffe Castle or the park and make a collage of what you saw.

#### Other

- PHSCE - design a poster on how to get on with others in the classroom.
- DT - design your own London Bus
- Music - make up a song about London.
- Geography - explore which countries are in the UK.
- Geography - make a flag for each country in the United Kingdom.
