Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example maths one week, creative the next etc. Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc..) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book (unless it is a model).

### English



- Write a poem about our theme, Stone Age.
- Write a description of a cave person including details about their clothes.
- Write a story based around our theme.
- Write a set of instructions how to create a Stone Age hut.



### Maths

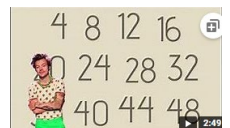


- Practice your 2,3,4,5,8 and 10 times tables.

- Create a song/rap to remember maths vocab.

- Create a poster to show what you know about measurement.

- Measure items at home using various units of measurement to record your findings.

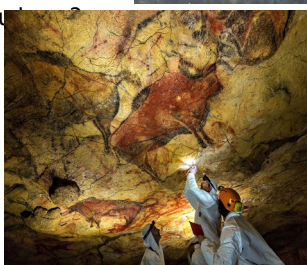


## Homework

### Creative



- Build a model linked to our Stone Age theme - be as creative and imaginative as you can. Use old boxes, bottles and scraps of paper that would be thrown away.
- Produce your own cave painting - practice for our wall painting project.
- Design and create a Stone Age tool - think about the materials you could use.
- Create a research or mind map of the Stone Age. What do you already know? What questions do you have?
- Design a leaflet or a poster which explains life in the Stone Age. Imagine you are trying to promote travelling back in time to the Stone Age as a holiday option.



### Other

- Know your Year 3 spellings and create sentences using these.
- Watch Newsround and summarise 2 stories including the headlines.
- Visit the library and find books to research our Stone Age theme.
- Design a word search or crossword using words linked to the Stone Age.
- Create a timeline of your own life.
- Keep a log table of your emotions this week. How do you feel? What has made you feel this way? Create your own images to show good / bad feelings.
