What will my child be learning this term? Our theme for this term is <u>Castles, Knights and</u> <u>Dragons!</u>

The imaginative role play area has become an Eastwood Castle, where the children can dress up as knights who lived in the Castle and how they lived in medieval times. They can grow their imaginations and practice using new vocabulary. There will be opportunities to apply newly learned literacy and mathematical skills in purposeful situations.

We will be designing and created our helmets, hats and shields, used our team building skills to look at how a castle is built and how we might make it safely across the moat.

How can I help my child at home?

•Check your child is doing their reading and handing it in on Wednesday.

•Listen to your child read every night and talk to them about the book (this can be done in English or the home language).

- •Ask them what they are learning about in school.
- Make sure they have equipment to do their **learning** at home.
