All of the homework options below are linked to either this theme or other learning from this term such as English / Maths / Science etc.... Pupils are expected to **read** for 15 minutes every day and practice their **phonics / spellings and times tables** every day as well in addition to choosing 1 or 2 things from the options below each week. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example Maths one week, creative the next etc...

Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc..) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book (unless it is a model).



#### English/Reading

Look at your library book. Write a short review and say if you enjoyed the book.

Find out about Amy Johnson and write a story about her.

Watch a video about Katie Morag and write a list of everything you found out.

Write a poem about an island.

Choose an island and create a fact file.

Write a description of a setting.

Send or design a postcard.

#### Maths

- Write your 5 and 10 x table.
- Can you find all the odd and even numbers in them?
- How many ways can you make 50 by using multiplication?
- Find  $\frac{1}{2}$  and  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Numbers to 30.
- Look at the clock and say the time to o'clock, ... quarter past.
- Write a shopping list and add up the cost.
- Go on a train and see how much it costs and how long it takes.
- Do some baking! Write a list of the ingredients and use measurements, e.g. litres, grams.

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#### Creative

- Can you make a model using natural materials?
- Make a bird feeder using recycled materials.



- Visit Cliffe Castle or the park. Which animals can you see? What are their habitats/microhabitats? Make a collage of them.
- Take a picture of or draw a microhabitat and label it.

#### Other

- Design a poster on how to get on with others in the classroom.
- Design your own ideal habitat.
- Make up a song about habitats.
- Explore which rivers are in the UK.
- Visit a museum and make a list of which things you see.
