_Our theme for this half term is: UK History; Anglo-Saxons and Viking Warriors

All of the homework options below are linked to either this theme or other learning from this term such as English / Maths / Science etc.... Pupils are expected to **read** for 15 minutes every day and practice their **spellings and times tables** every day as well in addition to choosing 1 thing from the options below each week. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example Maths one week, creative the next etc... Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc..) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book (unless it is a model).

English (Reading, Grammar, Spelling, Writing, Oracy, Handwriting)



Produce a book review about your class or library book

- Using the spelling list in your Reading Record, choose between 5 and 10 words and write a sentence including each spelling.
- Cursive handwriting practice ask for some lined paper if needed.
- 4. Write a summary of your favourite part of the book How to train your dragon.
- 5. Write a character description for Hiccup.

Maths (Calculation, Fractions and Decimals)



- Reach the top of the Year 4 leaderboard on TT Rockstars!
- Use multiplication and division methods to create some calculations to solve.
- Create a poster to explain how we add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions with step by step instructions
- Recall multiplication and division facts up to 12x12.
- 5) Multiply three numbers together.
- Multiply 2-digit numbers by a 1-digit number using formal written layout.

Creative (Art, DT, Music)

- Re-design the front cover of the book How to train your dragon.
