

Year group: 6 Our theme for this half term is: **World Superpowers: Ancient Baghdad/ America/ China**

All of the homework options below are linked to either this theme or other learning from this term such as English / Maths / Science etc.... Pupils are expected to **read** for 15 minutes every day and practice their **spellings and times tables** every day as well in addition to choosing 1 thing from the options below each week. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example Maths one week, creative the next etc... Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc..) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book (unless it is a model).

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English (Reading, Grammar, Spelling, Writing, Oracy, Handwriting)



1. Research and write about the Willow Pattern.
2. Produce an information leaflet about America, Baghdad or China.
3. Create a poem about being a slave.
4. Be a bookworm – read as many books as you can and recommend at least one book to a friend.
5. Retell the story of Kensuke's Kingdom (comic strip)
6. Create a wordle linked to our theme/ spellings
7. Choose an interesting text and spend 10 minutes copying the text in your best writing.
8. Choose an image from Pobble 365 and write a description.

Maths

(Number and Place Value, Arithmetic, Calculations)

- 1) Write a definition and create a poster about square numbers, common factors and prime numbers.
- 2) Use long multiplication and long division methods and create some calculations to solve.
- 3) Convert remainders into decimals and fractions.
- 4) Create a help sheet for calculating area and perimeter.
- 5) Multiply decimals $3.24 \times 7 = 12.45 \times 9$
- 6) Make a poster showing 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.
- 7) Present simple fractions, decimals and percentage equivalents and memorise key facts e.g $25/100 = \frac{1}{4} = 0.25 = 25\%$
- 8) Calculate 1% and 10% of different amounts remembering to use place value chart)
- 9) Use TT Rockstars and Year 6.co.uk

Creative (Art, DT, Music, Enrichment)



1. Create your own Willow Pattern design.
2. Create a sketch of a desert island.
3. Build a model of an item linked to America, Baghdad or China.
4. Bake/ cook a meal from America, Baghdad or China, write a list of ingredients for your recipe.
5. Create a model of a shelter you would build on a desert island.
6. Make a montage of music from America, Baghdad or China.
7. Make a pic collage of America, Baghdad and China and then present making comparisons.
8. Plan a whole school fundraising event inviting all year groups to join in with our work on different countries.
