
Year 1 Newsletter - Summer 1

Welcome to the fifth edition of our newsletter! We have lots of exciting things planned over the next few weeks. We hope that this newsletter will provide you with an overview of what will be happening in Year 1 this half term.



Our Theme this term is:

Come with me across the sea





We will be focusing on the texts Lost and Found and The Snail and the Whale. The children will learn to write simple and complex sentences incorporating adjectives, conjunctions and question marks. Our final piece of writing will be writing a letter to the penguin character in Lost and Found.









The children will cover a range of topics in Maths this half term. Our key focus is geometry and statistics. We will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes, we will be making our own tally charts and we will be learning directional clues including half, quarter and three-quarter turn. We will also be learning about money and identifying different notes and coins.





Science



In Science we will continue to observe the weather and understand how seasonal changes affect us. We will focus on the changes we see in Summer. We will also be comparing the weather to the South Pole linked to our books.

We will also be learning about Animals including Humans. The children will learn to name a variety of animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles birds and mammals, we will also sort animals into these categories. They will also learn to classify an animal by what it eats; whether it is a carnivore, herbivore or omnivore. We will also have a visit from Mrs Gray and Mrs Blicks dogs over the half term.

Geography





We will then move onto Art where we will continue learning about primary and secondary colours. We will also give opinions on the work on an artist. As our piece of art work we will create our own patterns and then combine these together as classes to make a blanket for the boy in our story Lost and Found.

Learning at Home

Reading: Children are expected to read for at least **20** minutes every day.



Please listen to your child read and encourage them to develop good reading habits. Ask your child questions about the texts they read and please fill in the reading records so we can give your child a new book.

<u>Library –</u> Every Tuesday, the children will spend half an hour in the library, where they will select a book they can take home and read for pleasure. Our library sessions will include a time for the children to read their books and also, we will provide them with an opportunity to listen to a range of texts.

Homework Menu

Children will be given a homework menu. They must choose an activity from either English, Maths, Creative or Other. Homework books will be given out on Friday and must be completed and handed in by **Wednesday.**

<u>Times tables</u>: By the end of year one children are expected to be able to count in 2, 5 and 10s. Regular practise of these is vital for your child to become secure with these facts. Please help your child to say and use their times tables.

Spellings

Children will be given a list of spellings every **Monday**. Please help your child to read and spell these correctly as they will be tested on these in class every **Friday**.
