All of the homework options below are linked to either this theme or other learning from this term such as English / Maths / Science etc.... Pupils are expected to **read** for 15 minutes every day and practice their **spellings and times tables** every day as well in addition to choosing 1 thing from the options below each week. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example Maths one week, creative the next etc... Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc..) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book (unless it is a model).



#### English ( Reading, Grammar, Spelling, Writing, Oracy, Handwriting)

1. Write an advert persuading people to visit the ancient Olympic Games.
2. Learn a poem to recite to the class that has a Greek theme or is based on a fable/myth.
3. Create a word search with a Greek theme.
4. Research a modern Greek island and make and write a postcard to someone, telling them all about your holiday there.
5. Find out what it was like for slaves in Ancient Greece. Imagine you are a slave and write a diary entry describing your day/week.

#### Maths (Number and Place Value, Arithmetic, Calculations)

1. Recall, recite and learn all your times table facts.
2. Create a poster to remember multiples of 3,5, etc...
3. Multiply 2 digit by 1, 3 digit by 1, 3 digit by 2 using short
4. Multiply 2 digit by 2 digits and 2 digits by 2 digits using long multiplication
5. Divide 3 digit by 1 using bus stop method.

#### Creative ( Art, DT, Music, Enrichment)

1. Make a Spartan helmet or design a shield.

3. Create a picture of an imaginary Greek god.
4. Design and make your own Labyrinth. What materials could you use?
5. The Ancient Greeks painted pictures on pots which have given us lots of information about how they lived. Design a picture to put on a plate or pot that displays an aspect of life in 2017 so the historians in the future can discover what life was like in the 21st century.

#### Homework

- Who was Pythagoras? How is he linked to maths? What is Pythagoras' theory? Present your findings – use diagrams to explain what you have learnt.
2. Create a short presentation about the origin of the Olympic games, you could include how the differed from the modern Olympics.
  3. Draw and label a map of Greece and plan a trip there. Which modes of transport would you use to get there from your house? Which countries would you pass through or over?
