- Practice writing, reading and counting with numbers to 100.

- Learn number bonds to 20.
- Create and solve number problems.

### Creative

- Build a model of a polar habitat.
- Bake a cake with an animal from the book Footprints in the snow on it.
- Draw and label different polar animals.
- Do a sponge painting of a winter scene.
- Design a winter scene with animal footprints in



5 and 10 times tables
