Our theme for this half term is: **FANTASTIC FANTASIES**

All of the homework options below are linked to either this theme or other learning from this term such as English / Maths / Science (**LIVING THINGS**) Pupils are expected to **read** for 15 minutes every day and practice their **phonics / spellings and times tables** every day as well in addition to choosing 1 thing from the options below each week. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example Maths one week, creative the next etc... Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc..) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book (unless it is a model).



### English

- Use a thesaurus and write synonyms (other words) for walked, shouted, scary, cold, hot.
- Write a poem about a dragon or mythical Creature.
- Create a fact file on a mythical creature (dragon, unicorn, Minotaur, Loch Ness monster, Griffin)
- Use adjectives to describe a mythical creature.
- Write facts about the different continents (Europe, Asia, Africa, Australia, North America, South America, Antarctica, using the internet or visit the library).

### Creative

- Create a painting of a mythical creature.



- Make a 3d model of a dragon.
- Make a map of the world – can you put the continents on.
- Bake a cake and turn it into The World.
- Bake some dragon buns
- Make a map of one of the 7 continents – which animals can you find in these habitats?



### Maths

- Create a number track for counting in 2s,3s,5s,10.
- Write out 2, 5 and 10 times Tables (extension – write out Tables up to 12)
- Draw times tables as arrays (look on BBC Bitesize) <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zqbg87h/articles/z3tvcj6>
- Quick fire tables (Go on to your TT Rockstars Login Choose <https://ttrockstars.com/page/mobileapp/>)
- Use real live problems to practice multiplication (eg 5 children all have 2 cakes each – how many cakes?)
- Use money to add and subtract amounts when you are out shopping.

### Other

- Watch Newsround and write down the two main stories including the headlines.



- Make a mini booklet about the 7 continents include key facts, flags and some illustrations.
- Go for a minibeast hunt – what
- Visit a zoo, a farm or a wildlife park and record the different habitats.
