All of the homework options below are linked to either this theme or other learning from this term such as English/Maths/Science etc. Pupils are expected to **read** for 15 minutes every day and practice their **phonics/spellings and times tables** every day as well in addition to choosing 1 or 2 things from the options below each week. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example Maths one week, creative the next etc. Work (which can include photographs/evidence of activities or visits etc.) should be recorded in this '*Learning at Home*' book (unless it is a model).

<u>English</u>

- Write a poem about the frozen world.
- Create your own story using a picture of the Northern Lights (Aurora Borealis).
- Read your books and write three retrieval questions and answer them.
- Create a fact file about your favourite Arctic animal.



Creative

- Draw and label a picture of an Arctic animal.
- Design and create a model of an Arctic animal.
 Think about how to make it lifelike.
- Draw a map of the world. Try to make it as accurate as possible.
- Create a model that uses forces.



<u>Maths</u>

- Count in steps of 2, 3, 4, 8, 50 and 100.
- Write and solve x and ÷ word problems using a winter theme.
- Revise addition and subtraction by practicing these written methods.
- Practice your written methods for multiplication and division.



<u>Other</u>

- Watch Newsround and summarise the two main stories including the headlines.
- Research your favourite Arctic animal.
- Create a word search or crossword about a country in the Northern Hemisphere
- Research three different real-world uses for different forces.
