Learning at Home Menu



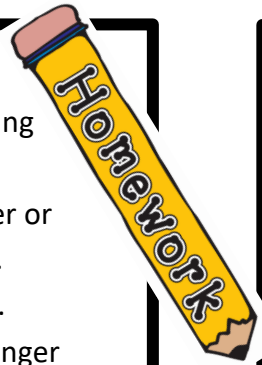
Year group: Nursery

Please find below some suggestions as to learning activities your child could be doing at home during this period of Government enforced school closure. This menu of activities is additional to the theme menus sent home at the beginning of term, which pupils can continue working on as well. **Pupils are expected to read for 15 minutes every day and practice their phonics / spellings and times tables every day as well as choosing activities from the selection below.** Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities each day / week. Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc.) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book to share when school re-opens.



English

- Learn to write your name using lowercase letters.
- Draw on large pieces of paper or cardboard (anything will do).
- Practice your nursery rhymes.
- Help to cook to strengthen finger muscles.
- Prepare a show get dressed up, make tickets, number the seats.
- See if you can read some of the labels from shops or recognize logos.



Maths

- Do some jigsaws
- Play shops using real money. Use 1p coins.
- Get your child to tidy and organize things ie knives, forks and spoons.
- See if your child can learn to write numerals and know their own age and those of their siblings.
- Play games with a dice and can they recognize the number of dots from the pattern.
- Count your fingers



Creative / Practical

- Bake with a family member.
- Learn a new game
- Dance to your favourite songs.
- Watch Newsround and summarise stories including the headlines.
- Prepare a show and tell about something you are interested in.
- Make a junk model
- Read stories aloud, tell stories about your families and make up new ones together.
