Please find below some suggestions as to learning activities your child could be doing at home during this period of Government enforced school closure. This menu of activities is additional to the theme menus sent home at the beginning of term, which pupils can continue working on as well. **Pupils are expected to read for 15 minutes every day and practice their phonics / spellings and times tables every day as well as choosing activities from the selection below.** Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities each day / week. Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc.) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book to share when school re-opens.

English

- Choose and complete a writing task from the Pobble365 website
- Create a bedtime story (including pictures)
- Read a newspaper and create your own comprehension questions to ask a family member
- Create a script and read/act it out with a family member
- Read a novel over 100 pages long and write a book review
- Create your own Newspaper article based on a story from Newsround

Maths

- Create a tally chart of how many different electrical items you have in your house– see if you can turn it into a bar graph!
- Imagine you have £100. What would you spend it on? How many items could you purchase? Make a list of the items and work out the total costing.
- Teach a person at home long multiplication/division.
- Create a word search with numbers written in words e.g. seventy five thousand, three hundred and twelve
- Practice your times tables on <http://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button> and record your scores or create a times table poster
