English

- Write a diary entry in the style of Eddie.
- Write an instruction leaflet for growing plants.
- Write a story about a secret garden.
- Learn a poem and recite it by heart.
- Write a poem about our theme.

Maths

- Learn your number bonds to 20
- Practice your 2, 5 and 10 times tables and division facts.
- Practice reading, writing and counting numbers up to 100.
- Play board games that use a dice.

Creative / Practical

- Research various minibeasts.

- Make a model of a garden using recyclable materials.
- Plant a seed from a fruit or packet if you have them and watch it grow. Measure it each day with a ruler.



Other
