Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities each day / week. English

- Write a recount about a journey you have been on.
- Make a map of a journey you have been on.
- Find out about Christopher Columbus or Neil Armstrong.
- Write about this famous person
- Write and send a letter or a postcard to a member of staff at school you can put the school address on.
- Listen to some stories about space on You Tube write a review.
- Practice spelling all the names of the planets
- Learn a poem about space and recite it by heart.
- Write a fantasy story about a journey to a different planet.




- Keep learning your tables (2,5,10,3,4,11)- ask someone to test you. (TT Rockstars)
- Practice adding two 2 digit numbers together (eg. 27 +37)
- Practice taking a one digit number from a 2 digit number (eg. 56 – 8)
- Measuring amounts using scales for baking or cooking
- Play Hit the button online Daily 10 (see link)
- Measure household items using a tape measure or a ruler keep a record of the measurements.
- Make a tally chart of food in your kitchen/cutlery/cars which go past your house.
