Write a different ending for the story. | <p>Maths – Complete Daily 10 of your choice Make sure it is hard enough for you. https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/daily10 If you can't access this, ask an adult to give you a times tables Test. <u>Division</u> Collect 20/30 (choose a number) of small objects from around your house (beads/pasta pieces/dried beans) Can you divide them into 2/3/5/10 equal parts. Record your division sum – can you write a multiplication sum to go with it. 20 divided by 5 = 4 5 X 4 = 20</p> | <p>English Watch the information clip about foxes. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=4_zEiHhvqF0 Can you make a non-fiction fact file about foxes? Can you find a tape measure or a ruler to measure them? How else could you measure them? |
| <p>Outdoor learning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mini Beast hunt Read Outside Multiplication Hopscotch (write a multiplication sum in each square) | <p>Science/DT Now you have heard the story of Egg Drop, Could you think of your own idea to protect a real egg from breaking if you were to drop it from a height? If you can't think of any ideas, search egg drop on You Tube.</p> | <p>Science/DT Can you find a real egg and make your design to protect your egg. Watch https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=tnznCx48FH8 When you have made your design – test it by dropping it from a height.</p> | <p>Art Make a rainbow out of paper, felt-tips, collage and put it in your window for everyone to see. Write a message about “Staying safe” to put next to your rainbow. Draw an outline of an egg – can you decorate it using repeating patterns and pictures.</p> | <p>Music Sing your favourite song and can you find objects around your house that make different noises?
