Dear Parents,

From Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June, your child will be returning to school therefore we would like to address some important rules which we have put in place and which they **MUST** adhere to in order to keep themselves and everyone they come into contact with, safe.

## Timings

- Please arrive at school promptly for 9am. Children will leave school at 3pm.
- School will be open 9am-3pm Mon-Thurs and 9-12 on Fridays, to allow for deep cleaning on Fri pm. Children will not need to bring a lunch on these days.

## Clothing

- School uniform (or, if it doesn't fit / isn't clean, in clothes as close to uniform as possible).
- Clean uniform / clothing must be worn every day please.

## Gates and doors

- They **MUST ONLY** enter the school grounds via the Year 6 gate (near the adventure playground) alone - NO ADULTS ARE ALLOWED ON THE SCHOOL GROUNDS PLEASE to support social distancing. A member of staff will meet you at the gate.
- Children will be asked to wait outside 6NW ensuring they are 2-metres apart on the footprint markings, as per the Government's social distancing guidelines.

## What do they need to bring?

- Please DO NOT bring items to school – no book bags, pencil cases, water bottles etc....
- Children bringing packed lunches are to bring them in a disposable plastic bag. They will not bring this home with them.
- Fresh water bottles will be provided to each child every day.

## How will we keep them safe?

- When entering 6NW, each child **MUST WASH THEIR HANDS** thoroughly before taking their seat
- Children will be allocated their own tables, where they will find their own personal resource pack, and this will be theirs for the duration of time in school (only 8 per class)
- Cloakrooms will be out-of-bounds so coats will be hung on the back of their chairs
- If a child needs to go the toilet (they will be accompanied by an adult), they **MUST WASH THEIR HANDS** before leaving and when re-entering the classroom
- Lunchtimes and break-times will be staggered to comply with social distancing regulations. Children **MUST WASH THEIR HANDS** before going out and when re-entering, lunches will be eaten at their desks in class
