- Draw a picture of the different veggies in the supermarket and label each character, don't forget the evil pea!
- Write a sentence about your favourite part of the story.
- Think of your own superhero vegetable. What vegetable would it be? What would its super power be? Write labels

- Practice counting forward and backwards from 10, 20, 50 and if your really clever 100 using the link

- Practise making your own addition and subtraction sentences using practical resources and then writing it as a number sentence.
- Make your own number bonds to 5 and 10 eg  
 $1+4=5$     $2+3=5$     $3+2=5$
- When your grown up buys potatoes or carrots, put them into size order
- Learn how to double numbers eg  $1+1=2$
- Learn your doubles to 10

### Creative / Practical

- Get your mum or dad to make a shape in one half of a potato and make a potato print picture using paints.
- Make a supertato or evil pea using junk modelling you have at home.
- Make a face using different fruit and vegetables, get your grown up to help you take a photograph.
- Design and make your own superhero bangle or cuff using different tubes
