<u>English</u>



Learn your tricky words. Write them in your book in different colours.

Practice writing your name in your book - use different pens.

Write a list of what you would put in a magic potion. Can you hear and write the first sound in each word.

Draw some rhyming words (cat and mat, dog and log, hen and pen) and label them.



everyday life – ask your child what number house they live at? How many steps does it take to get from your sofa to the door? Collect groups of objects – what is one more? Order numbers up to 10/20. Jumble them up again and have another go. Practice writing numbers to 20.

Make a pattern in your books and talk about how you did it.

Draw a haunted House or a witch using the 2D shapes that you know (triangle, circle, rectangle, square)



<u>Creative</u>

Use the recycling at home to create something – let your imagination run wild – a broomstick, a witch, a haunted house! Experiment with mixing colours – anyway you like. What happens when you mix the colours together? You could use food colouring in icing.

Can you create a dance routine to your favourite song? What ways of moving can you put in it?

Make some magical biscuits or buns with sparkles on.

Watch some fireworks or sparklers with an adult.

<u>Other</u>

Make a story up for your family. Can you make the main character a witch or a dragon ?

Talk about a wedding you have been to draw a picture of it and label it.
