All of the homework options below are linked to either this theme or other learning from this term such as English / Maths / Science etc.... Pupils are expected to **read** for 15 minutes every day and practice their **phonics / spellings and times tables** every day as well in addition to choosing 1 thing from the options below each week. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example Maths one week, creative the next etc... Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc.) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book (unless it is a model).



English

Watch and listen to What the Ladybirds Heard on you tube.

- Write a list of all the animals the Lady bird hears..
- Write down any words that rhyme e.g. hen and pen or hog and dog.
- Draw a map of the farm like Hefty Hugh and Lanky Len did.
- Create a new front cover the book What the Ladybird Heard.
- Make a prediction about your reading book.
- Who is your favourite character in your reading book. Give reasons why?
- Make a list of adjectives you could use to describe a farm animal, stripy cat, huge horse.

Maths

- Practise forming numbers correctly.
- Add two single digit numbers together.
- What is doubling? Write a description of how to double.
- Make up your own subtraction number sentences e.g. $10 - 5 = 5$.
- What does halving mean? Draw pictures of shapes and colour half of the shape.
- Take photographs of you doubling and halving using objects or shapes.
- Count on and back in 2s 5s and 10s.
