Our theme for this half term is: The World We Live In

All of the homework options below are linked to either this theme or other learning from this term such as English / Maths / Science etc.... Pupils are expected to **read** for 15 minutes every day and practice their **phonics / spellings and times tables** every day as well in addition to choosing 1 thing from the options below each week. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example Maths one week, creative the next etc... Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc..) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book (unless it is a model).

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English

Watch Eddie's Garden and how to make things grow on you tube. Write a summary of the story.

- At the beginning of the story mum wrote a list. Write a list of all the things that plants need to grow.
- Write a list of verbs that you will need to help you plant seeds e.g. dig, plant, find, put
- Write a set of instructions to plant a seed.
- Create a new front cover the book Eddie's garden
- Make a prediction about your reading book.
- Use your reading book and write what you like, dislike, characters and events
- Take a look in your book and write down any sentences that use an ! and a ?
- Find as many words that have the suffix ing, er or est and record them in your book.

Maths

- Recall and write doubles and halves of numbers up to 20.
- Recognise odd and even numbers and explain why the numbers are even or odd.
- Write down multiplication and division facts for 2, 3, 5 and 10. E.g $2 \times 5 = 10$
 $5 \times 2 = 10$ 10 divided by 2 = 5 10 divided by 5 = 2
- Know the value of numbers – Choose a 2 digit number and write how many tens and ones.
- 24 has 2 tens and 4 ones. $20 + 4 = 24$.
- Choose numbers and add them together. You could use a number line or use tens and ones.

Homework

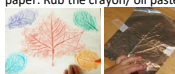
Creative

Make a plan of your ideal garden. What plants would you include? Remember to label each plant.

Using natural objects, lentils, coloured rice make a natural mandala.



Create some **leaf rubbings** using oil pastels, pencil crayons. Pick some dry leaves. Put the leaf under your piece of paper. Rub the crayon/oil pastel on the paper on top of your leaf. Watch your leaf rubbing appear on your paper.



You can even try it with tin foil!

Draw a map of your local area.



Draw and label the **parts of a tree**. Explain the functions of each part.



Design and make a slug trap to stop slugs eating your seedlings



Use twigs and other natural objects to make rain sticks and other objects

Other

- Read the story Stickman and use twigs to make your own stickman.



- Interview your grandparents or an older family member and ask them about games they used to play with and what life was like when they were younger
- Find out about toys, school life, transport and hospital in the past.
- Watch Newsround and summarise at least two stories
