Go on a number hunt — what numbers can you find?

Find different ways to make 10 (1+9 2+8 3+7) or 20 (19+1 18+2 17+3)

Count in 2's, 5's and 10's

Count out some different Coins and find the total.

Make a pirate ship from junk modelling boxes — can you create your own scary pirate to captain your box ship?

Paint a pirate or a pirate ship.

Make a treasure island

Draw around a family member — can you turn them into a pirate? Arghhh!
