You will also be given CGP homework where appropriate.



### English

- Research about sea creatures and make a booklet.
- Draw and label the seaside.
- Draw and label a plant or tree.
- Write a story set on a beach
- Write an acrostic poem about the seaside.

### Maths

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- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Create multiplication and division problems
- Create a 3D model of a shape and name the shape.
- Learn 2 and 5 times table
- Use coins to make 10p in different ways.

## Homework

### Creative

- Build a lighthouse
- Make a 3D shoe box beach scene.
- Create a picture using materials found outside.
- Paint a picture of a seaside environment.
- Experiment with a variety of objects to see which will float or sink.

- Go to the library and find out about seaside holidays in the past.
- Visit pets at home and sketch some fish
- Visit a beach and have fun!
- Go for a long summer walk and write about what you have seen.
