English

Go on a sound hunt (s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, c, k, e, u, r, o, h, b, f) - Choose a sound - find an object starting with this sound.
Practice spelling your tricky words (in book bags)

Practice writing name with capital at the start **only**.

Go and visit Keighley library and choose a book a book to borrow.



Maths



Collect conkers, acorns or leaves - practice counting.

Cut out numbers and make a number line - 1-10 or 1-20.

Go on a shape hunt outside or inside - can you see triangles, rectangles, circles and squares.

Draw and label shapes in your homework book.



Creative

Make skeletons from sticks

Make a house from old boxes for Funnybones - make windows, doors and a roof.

Make a skeleton out of paper.

Paint a skeleton

Paint a dark, dark town.



Draw around a family member - can you draw on the bones.

Other



Make shape biscuits

Make a healthy snack which will keep your bones healthy.

Act out the story of Funnybones for your family.
