English

_Go on a sound hunt. (Find objects starting with the weekly phonics sounds)

Can you remember the letter name that goes with the sound? (c,k ck,e u,r h,b f,l ll,ss)

Learn to read the tricky words
(the, to, I, no, go, into)
Now can you spell them?
Go and visit Keighley library and choose a book to borrow. Can you find a story about witches, fairies or dragons?
Write a recipe for a magical potion
Draw and label what you would put in yo potion.

Creative

Use the recycling at home to create a magical creature.

Make a firework picture.

Draw and label a witch or a wizard Experiment with mixing colours anyway you like. What happens when you mix the colours together? Can you create a dance routine to your favourite song? What ways of moving can you put in it?

<u>Maths</u>

Keep an eye out for numbers in your everyday life - ask your child what number house they live at. What number bus do you take? How many steps does it take to get from your sofa to the door? How many stairs in your house?

Order numbers up to 5/10/20. Jumble them up again and have another go. Find different ways to make 5. (eg land4, 2and3, 4and1)

Collect pine cones or stones and use them as counters.

Other

Make some toffee/chocolate dipped apples for Bonfire Night

Bake some bonfire cupcakes

Make some magical potions - you could do this in the bath or go outside and collect natural things for your potion (sticks, stones, flowers, berries)
