All of the homework options below are linked to either this theme or other learning from this term such as English / Maths / Science etc.... Pupils are expected to **read** for 15 minutes every day and practice their **phonics / spellings and times tables** every day as well in addition to choosing 1 thing from the options below each week. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example Maths one week, creative the next etc... Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc..) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book (unless it is a model).

### English

- Write a shopping list of your favourite foods which you would like to take on a picnic
- Write sentences about The Lighthouse Keeper, use capital letters and full stops.
- Make a story map. Draw the events which happen in the story and then label or write a small caption to go with it.
- Draw a picture of one from either story. Write describe what they look like and how they feel.



### Maths

- Play hit the button. Chose one of the different maths programs to play

- Recognise, read and write numbers from 0-100 and backwards.
- Add and subtract numbers to 10, 20, 50 and above show how you have solved eg using a picture. Or explain how you have solved.

1 2s. Learn to count in rote in 2s to the number you can. Learn the 2 times table eg

$$0 \times 2 = 0$$

$$1 \times 2 = 2$$

### Creative

- With an adult, make your own favourite sandwich. Ask a grown up to take a photograph and stick in your homework book.
- Build a lighthouse from any old boxes, cylinders, paper. Bring it to school. Be as creative as you can!
- Watch fireworks with an adult, then draw, paint or collage the fireworks you have seen in the night's sky.
- Design and make a Christmas card for one of your friends at school. CHALLENGE..... design a card which shows different light sources
