All of the homework options below are linked to either this theme or other learning from this term such as English / Maths / Science etc.... Pupils are expected to **read** for 30 minutes every day and practice their **phonics / spellings and times tables** every day as well in addition to choosing 1 or 2 things from the options below each week. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example maths one week, creative the next etc... Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc..) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book (unless it is a model).



English

Imagine that you have just been on a fossil hunt. Write a diary entry about what you have found.

- Choose a dinosaur and write a fact file, book or poster all about them.
- Write 10 adjectives (describing words) about your favourite dinosaur.
- Write a dinosaur poem or story.
- Find out the food that a herbivore dinosaur would eat. Is that food still around today?
- Find out the food that a carnivore dinosaur would eat. Is that food still around today?
- Create a dinosaur diner menu!

<u>Maths</u>

- Keep practicing your times tables (2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10).
 You can use your log in for Times Table Rock Stars or Hit the Button if you want to play online. Our maths learning for this half term is multiplication and division so this will really help you.
- Create dinosaur word problems (e.g. if one dinosaur has 4 legs, how many legs do 3 dinosaurs have?)
- Draw a picture of a dinosaur using only 2D shapes.
- Create a table with the titles Herbivore and Carnivores. Research some dinosaurs. How many were herbivores and how many were carnivores?

Homework

Creative

- Make a 3D junk model dinosaur.
- Use a computer to draw a picture of a dinosaur.
- Can you find out what the 3 stages of the Mesozoic Era are? Which stage was the T-Rex in?
- Think about where dinosaurs lived. Draw their habitat or create a shoebox habitat.
- Design a dinosaur mask.
- Create your *own* dinosaur, then draw and label it.
- Write a dinosaur rap or song.
- Working with a friend or family, make up a dinosaur alphabet. Make a list naming at least one dinosaur for every letter for the alphabet.
- Write some dinosaur jokes and then share them with your family and friends.

- Watch Newsround and summarise the two main stories including the headlines.
- Know your Phase 2 to Phase 5 phonemes and create words using these.
- Research dinosaurs and find out which was the tallest, smallest, quickest, heaviest etc.
- Can you create a timeline from the Triassic period to when the dinosaurs became extinct?
