- Each child is expected to spend 15 minutes a day on their homework

English

- Describe your favourite character from a fiction book. (full English lesson rules apply!)
- Write a letter to a famous inventor of your choice about their most famous invention.
- If you could invent anything, what would it be and why? (remember, your HW should be a FULL PAGE)

Maths

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- Go to the shops with your parents, and add up the prices of everything you bought.
- Can you convert Pounds and Pence into just Pence?
- Don't forget to practice your times tables (NOT IN HERE!)
- Can you think of how you might use fractions at home?

Creative

Homework

- Imagine you have a cardboard tube, some sticky tape, some string, and some magnets. What could you invent?
- Make a model of an invention. Be sure to include a drawing of the marks for it having moving parts.
- Make your own book, including a cover.
- Bake a cake, and cut it into fractions – take photos / draw diagram to show which fractions you used!



Other

- Watch Newsround and write about 2 stories.
- Research who invented your favourite machine, and present a top 10 of your favorite facts.
- Prepare a show and tell about how it was invented.
- Make a list of all the electrical and battery-powered things in your house...
- ...Can you make a venn diagram out of that list?
