


# Reception Newsletter Autumn 1 2023-2024

### Reading Books

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# Reception Timings

The school day finishes at 3.15PM. Please collect your child from the Reception playground doors. It is important that you pick your child up on time. If your child is not collected by 3:20pm they will be taken to the school office and will need to be collected from there.
