What will my child be learning this term?

Phonics

The children are recognising, hearing, saying and writing letters ,ck,e,u,r,h,b, f, ff, l, ll, ss

Your child will be bringing home tricky words to learn with their reading books.

Maths

The children will be learning to recognise, order, write, count and subitising numbers to 5/10 – subitise means to instantaneously recognise the number of objects in a small group without the need to count them. They will be learning about the different shape and the key features. They will be learning about **time** for example sequencing the day.

How can I help my child at home?

- Ask your child what they have been **learning about** in school.
- Please make sure your child completes one piece of home learning from the menu every week. Books to be handed in on a Monday.
- Please listen to your child read their book at home regularly (this can be done in English or the home language) – use the questions in their reading records.

Remember to keep your reading books in the clear bag they were sent home in. Your child will need to bring this to school every day.
