All of the homework options below are linked to either this theme or other learning from this term such as English / Maths / Science etc....

Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example Maths one week, creative the next etc... Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc..) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book (unless it is a model).

English (Reading, Grammar, Spelling, Writing, Oracy, Handwriting)



1. Produce an information leaflet about Protecting the Environment.
2. Write a rap/song about how we can help protect the moorlands and our local environment.
3. Be a bookworm – read as many books as you can and recommend at least one book to a friend.
4. Create a role on the wall / character description about the Paper Bag Prince
5. Create a wordle linked to our theme/ spellings
6. Choose an interesting text and spend 10 minutes copying the text in your best writing.
7. Create Play the game Summary Bullseye
8. Make a wordsearch with key vocabulary from our topic.

Maths (Number and Place Value, Arithmetic, Calculations)

1. Keep a record of any money you have collected.
2. Buy ingredients and calculate the costs to make a vegetable soup.
3. Write the date every day in Roman numerals.
4. Create a board game (monopoly, snakes and ladders) and create addition and subtraction questions.
5. Use the websites (TT ROCKSTARS, SATS BOOTCAMP, TOP MARKS)
6. Explain how to add/ subtract numbers beyond 5 digits.
7. Learn how to use long division and teach a friend.

Homework

Creative (Art, DT, Music, Enrichment)



1. Bake a cake as a treat your family. Remember to take photographs of your finished product.
2. Create a model using recycled materials
3. Make your own rubbish dump collage using recycled objects.
4. Learn a new song/ poem to perform in front of an audience,
5. Bring in recycled materials into school and research ways in which you could re-use, reduce or recycle the material.
6. Plan a pollution experiment – water pollution, noise pollution or air pollution – keep a survey.

Other (LOTC, Geography, History, PSHCE...)

1. Follow a cooking recipe/instructions to make a dish. Plan a day out and travel on bus/train.
2. Research and find out where your rubbish goes.
3. Healthy body, healthy mind – Plan and carry out physical activity with your family and friends.
4. Stroll through nature – Take a walk in the local area/ any park and collect some natural materials.
5. Visit the cinema and write a review of the film you've watched.
6. Be a community champion and help to pick up litter, recycle and help a neighbour.
7. Create a food log/ diary of the food you have consumed.
