All of the homework options below are linked to either this theme or other learning from this term such as English / Maths / Science etc.... Pupils are expected to **read** for 15 minutes every day and practice their **phonics / spellings and times tables** every day as well in addition to choosing 1 or 2 things from the options below each week. Try to ensure you do a balance of different activities over the half term, for example Maths one week, creative the next etc... Work (which can include photographs / evidence of activities or visits etc..) should be recorded in this Learning at Home book (unless it is a model).



• English/Reading

- Look at your library book. Write a short review and say if you enjoyed the book.
- Write a description about Orion. Can you draw a picture and label him?
- Write a list of all the words that rhyme with Dark?
- Write a list of things that make you scared.
- Create your own story inspired by the book.
- Write a letter to a character in the story.
- Write a book review about our story or your reading book.

Maths

- Create a number sequence of counting in 3s.
- Can you find 5 ways of making 25?
- How many ways can you make 20 by taking away?
- Practice writing your numbers to 100 in 5s and 10s.
- Practice writing multiples of 3 and 5 using chalk.
- Count the number of shadows you can find, draw a picture of them and number them.



Creative

- Can you make a model using different materials?
- Write down which materials you can find in your house.
- Visit Cliffe Castle or the park. Which materials have been used for the slide and swings?
- Paint a picture of the hills around you.
- Visit the canal in Riddlesden or Kildwick and take a photograph.

Other

- Can you dribble a ball in the park or play catch with somebody in your family.
- Design your own monster and say what it can do.
- Make a shadow puppet using a torch.
- Use a torch to explore your house in the dark.
- Look at the stars and moon in the dark sky.
