Welcome to the fourth edition of our newsletter! We have lots of exciting things planned over the next few weeks. We hope that this newsletter will provide you with an overview of what will be happening in Year 1 this half term.



Our Theme this term is:

How does your garden grow?





<u>ENGLISH</u> - We will be focusing on the texts The Secret Sky Garden and The Secret Garden. The children will learn to write simple and complex sentences incorporating different punctuation to demarcate sentences correctly. Our final piece of writing will be a setting description,







the children will learn all about fractions, halving and quartering. They will learn how to halve and quarter shapes and amounts and will learn the symbols to show one half and one quarter.



Science



In Science we will continue to observe the weather and understand how seasonal changes affect us. We will focus on the changes we see in Spring.

We will also be learning about plants. including deciduous trees and ever green trees. The children will learn to label a part of a plant including petals, stem, leaf and root. We will also look in detail about the parts of a tree. We will learn about the different functions of the parts of the plants and trees.

Art



In theme the children will begin the half term learning about the artist Georgia O'Keefe. We will give an opinion on her work by discussing the things that we like or dislike about her work. We will also think of questions about her work. We will then move onto creating lines of different thickness using pencils and use this skill in our drawings. We will learn the skill of quilling by cutting, rolling and coiling materials.

Keeping myself safe and Rights and Responsibilities

The children will continue to learn about how to keep themselves safe including online safety and understanding the safety and responsibility of medicines. Online safety is a really important topic and it would be helpful if you could discuss online safety at home with your children. In the final few weeks we will move onto learning about rights and responsibilities; this will continue into the summer term. We will recognise how our behaviour can affect others and we will learn about our school environment.

Learning at Home

Reading: Children are expected to read for at least **20** minutes every day.



Please listen to your child read and encourage them to develop good reading habits. Ask your child questions about the texts they read and please fill in the reading records so we can give your child a new book.

<u>Library –</u> Every Tuesday, the children will spend half an hour in the library, where they will select a book they can take home and read for pleasure. Our library sessions will include a time for the children to read their books and also, we will provide them with an opportunity to listen to a range of texts.

Homework Menu

Children will be given a homework menu. They must choose an activity from either English, Maths, Creative or Other. Homework books will be given out on Friday and must be completed and handed in by **Wednesday.**

<u>Times tables</u>: By the end of year one children are expected to be able to count in 2, 5 and 10s. Regular practise of these is vital for your child to become secure with these facts. Please help your child to say and use their times tables.

Spellings

Children will be given a list of spellings every **Monday**. Please help your child to read and spell these correctly as they will be tested on these in class every **Friday**.
