- Write a poetry review. It could be your favourite rhyming book, one you have read recently, or a poem we have learnt in school. What do you like about it or dislike about it? Can you summarise what happens? Who are the main characters, what do they do and why?
- Write a report of your first day in the Roman army. What did you do?

- Watch times tables songs on Youtube to help you practice.














Creative
