## What will my child be learning this term?

English 🕮

In our English lessons, we will be reading and exploring 'Kensuke's Kingdom.' This is a great novel and allows the children to walk in the shoes of a young boy who is stranded on an island. Find out what happens next. We will be writing a diary entry in Michael's perspective.







## **Fractions, Decimals and Percentages**

We will be revisiting how to add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions therefore pupils will need to use multiplication knowledge and know common multiples, common factors and prime numbers. We will also revise how to calculate simple percentage of amounts.

## Geometry (2D and 3D shapes)

In maths we will be describing, comparing and classifying geometric 2D shapes and 3D shapes based on the properties and sizes. We be learning about the different angles and calculating missing angles.

## Reflection, Rotation, Translation, Coordinates

We will also be learning about coordinates and reflecting, rotating and translating shapes.

### **Area, Perimeter and Volume**

Also, we will be working on finding the area of shapes including triangles and parallelograms. We will also calculate, estimate and compare volume of cubes and cuboids, using standard units.

## Talking at Home

We encourage you to talk to your child about their learning in class. Ask them what they have learnt each day or something new which they have found out. ## World Superpowers: Ancient Baghdad/ America/China

History



We will be going back through time to learn about the UK history through the decades. We will be identifying and explaining then differences, similarities and changes between different periods of history and how these have impacted on our lives today.

In our Art lessons, we will be creating art work that has influenced by historical periods. We will be using a range of e-resources to create art we will be creating Islamic art.

#### **Guided Reading**





In our guided reading sessions, we will be developing our skills to read for meaning, make inferences and considering the language and layout of the texts.

Science



Light

In our Science lessons we will building on the work on Light in Year 3; we will be exploring the way light behaves, including light sources, reflection and shadows. We will be exploring how light words and demonstrating how we see objects. We will investigate the relationships between light, objects and shadows by using shadow puppets. In the lessons we will be using simple optical instruments. periscope, telescope, binoculars, mirror, magnifying glass and explaining how these work.
