#### What will my child be learning this term? Our theme for this term is Growing!

The imaginative role play area has become an Eastwood Garden Centre, where the children can dress up as gardeners for example, gardening is a great physical development activity. Children can practice locomotor skills, body management skills and object control skills while they move from one place

to the other carrying tools, soil and water. Gardening requires children to practice and hone in on their fine motor skills. Planting seeds, scooping dirt and watering plants all help to improve motor skills, which can in term help to improve their concentration and learning capabilities.



How can I help my child at home?

- Check your child is doing their reading and handing it in on Wednesday AM and PM
- •Listen to your child read every night and talk to them about the book (this can be done in English or the home language).
- •Ask them what they are learning about in school.
- Make sure they have equipment to do their **learning** at home.
- Register your child for **free books every month** from birth to 5 years of age on **Keighley's Imagination**
