<u>Maths</u>

Counting and recognising numbers past 10. One more/one less Length, weight capacity, Number bonds to 10. Subtraction from 10.

How can I help my child at home?

- •Ask your child what they have been **learning about** in school.
- •Please make sure your child completes one piece of home learning from the menu every week. Books to be handed in on a Monday.
- •Please listen to your child read their book at home regularly (this can be done in English or the home language) use the questions in their reading records.
