English/Reading



- Invent and draw an animal pirate and write a short description about it.
- Visit the library - which books can you find about the ocean?
- Write about an ocean explorer.
- Look at the clock. Can you write a diary of your daily activities on the weekend?
- Find out some facts about ships. Use subheadings to present them.



Creative

- Make a model of a ship using recycled materials.
- Make a telescope or a ship's steering wheel.
 - Create a map using art and craft materials.



Maths



- Look at the clock when you wake up, have breakfast or even go to bed. Draw and label the times on clock faces.
- Weigh out some ingredients and make a smoothie or a cake.
- Write your number bonds to 100.
- Count in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s forwards and backwards.
- Compare numbers and use greater than and less than signs. < >
- Choose an item from a shop and work out how much change you will need. Tell the shopkeeper!

Other

- Make up a song about the oceans and continents.
- Travel on a bus and save the ticket. How many ways could you use coins to pay for the ticket?
